

From the Desk of the Parish Director

Perhaps you have read or heard about the Archdiocesan Planning Process, headed by Father Jim Connell, Vicar for Planning for our archdiocese. (There was an article in the Catholic Herald a few months ago.) Since early July, Father Jim has been busy gathering information, holding listening sessions, town hall meetings, and taking on the serious challenge of creating a plan to present to Archbishop Dolan. Father Jim notes that his work will be accomplished in four phases. The first phase has been underway since the summer and is basically an information gathering phase. Phase two will be a presentation of various options. Phase three will be a draft of proposals, and phase four will be the finalization of the plan, which will be presented to Archbishop Dolan in June 2008.

This pastoral plan is for all parishes and ministries of the Archdiocese of Milwaukee—parishes, schools, archdiocesan offices, and the funding of all these. Our Parish Council and Finance/ Administration Committee has been reviewing and discussing the **Discussion Draft** that Father Jim authored to begin the feedback process.

Several issues are raised, including the continuing and worsening shortage of priests, the challenge of adequate funding and staffing for Catholic schools. the demographic changes and their effect on parishes: and other concerns.

When I first began sharing this planning effort with our parish leadership, I heard the comment, "We already have been through that." While it's true that there have been other planning processes in the past, there is a need in the archdiocese of a coordinated plan that will take into consideration all the parishes and resources of the archdiocese, a comprehensive archdiocese pastoral plan that "provides the vision and information necessary for him (the archbishop) to structure the organization and operation of the Archdiocese of Milwaukee for many years to come."

Our parish leadership bodies will continue to be a part of this process throughout the next several months. Please keep this planning process in your prayers.

Bulletin Deadline for Thanksgiving

Due to publication deadlines, there is an altered schedule for bulletin submissions surrounding the Thanksgiving Holiday. The November 18th bulletin will have the normal deadline of the Monday before, November 12th, by 8:30AM. The weekend after Thanksgiving, November 25th bulletin must be sent to our publication company earlier than normal. Therefore, the bulletin deadline for submissions is **Wednesday, November 14th by 12:00 noon**. Please note that all bulletin deadlines are firm and any submission after the deadline may not be printed in a timely matter. Thank you for your cooperation.

Parish Stewardship Cards/Mailing

Thanks to all who have returned their 2007-2008 Parish Stewardship Commitment Cards. We begin the third phase of our stewardship effort with calls to all parish members who have not returned their stewardship cards by this weekend, November 4th. Members of the Parish Council and the Finance/Administration Committee will be making the calls. If you haven't returned your stewardship card, please do so. Cards and ministry lists are available on the tables at the entrances of the church.

Reminder to All Parish Groups/Committees Regarding Bulletin Inserts and Flyers

In order to assure that a bulletin insert or flyer gets in our parish bulletin, the following procedure needs to be followed:

- 1. Inserts/flyers must be submitted at least **three weeks** in advance of the bulletin publication.
- 2. Inserts must either be camera-ready for duplication or the group/committee must provide 350 copies.
- 3. The group/committee is responsible for stuffing the inserts/flyers in the bulletins.
- 4. Colored paper may be requested. All copies will be duplicated using the "black and white" setting of the copier. Color copies are not provided.

Often an announcement in the body of the bulletin and a pulpit announcement are as effective as a special insert/flyer. When submitting inserts/flyers, please weigh the cost of the flyer/insert against its effectiveness.

Have a Message, Concern, Question, or Suggestion for Our Maintenance Team?

Both of our Maintenance Staff, Toni Timm and Mike Davis, are employed by our parish on a part-time basis. Toni Timm works twenty-one hours per week on Mondays, Wednesday, and Thursdays. Mike Davis works fifteen hours per week on a variable basis, but usually one weekday and some evening hours. They handle all our maintenance issues and projects and utilize volunteers whenever possible. If a light is burnt out, supplies are needed in the rest rooms, building needs repairs, etc., you can get a message to them in the following ways: (1) call the parish office and leave a message for the Maintenance Team; (2) write the message, address it to the Maintenance Team, and place it in the IN BOX in the sacristy; or (3) e-mail the parish and write the message for the Maintenance Team. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation. Remember, it takes all of us doing our part to keep our parish vital.
