### From the Desk of the Parish Director

◆ Next weekend, February 7th/8th is World Day of Prayer for Consecrated Life. Sister Judy Miller, CSJ will be speaking on the call to consecrated life as a religious sister and the call to associate membership in a religious congregation/order. Since the renewal efforts of Vatican II, most religious orders have developed lay associate programs in which married, single, and widowed women and men can be connected to the religious order through their charism and apostolic ministry.

Sister Judy, of the Sisters of St. Joseph of Carondelet, ministered here at St. Therese while I was on sabbatical from July through September 2008. She currently is ministering in the Diocese of Green Bay as Spiritual Director and Pastoral Associate at St. Joseph Parish in Bear Creek.

We will have ham and rolls after the 8:00AM and 10:00AM masses to welcome her back to our parish community and to have a little mid-winter treat!

◆ At the Chairperson's Meeting for our St. Therese Faith In Our Future Capital Campaign, we decided to focus on one campaign at a time. So, on February 14th/15th, Tony Ziebert, our parish chairperson, will speak to our congregation about the 2009 Catholic Stewardship Appeal. We also will listen during mass to an audiotape with Archbishop Dolan's message. A direct mailing from the archdiocese is going out to all registered parish members this week. It has been reported that the contributions from this first mailing generate more than 65% of the goal! 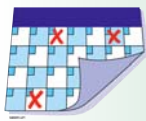
### Have You Lost an Item or Left It in Church?

### Finance/Administration Committee Update

#### 2009-2010 Parish Operating Budget

On Tuesday, January 20th, the Finance/Administration Committee took its first review of the 2009-2010 Parish Operating Budget. Thanks to all who worked on this budget in maintaining and cutting expenses and estimating realistic revenues. Currently, we are \$14,700 away from balancing the budget. Archdiocesan policy requires a deficit budget of any amount to be submitted to the archbishop's office for financial review. Since it is our goal to balance the budget, the Finance/Administration Committee and Parish Council will continue to work on the budget, raising revenues wherever we can and cutting and curbing expenses however we can. We appreciate the faithful financial stewardship of our members, our visitors, and families of loved ones who share memorial gifts with our community.
