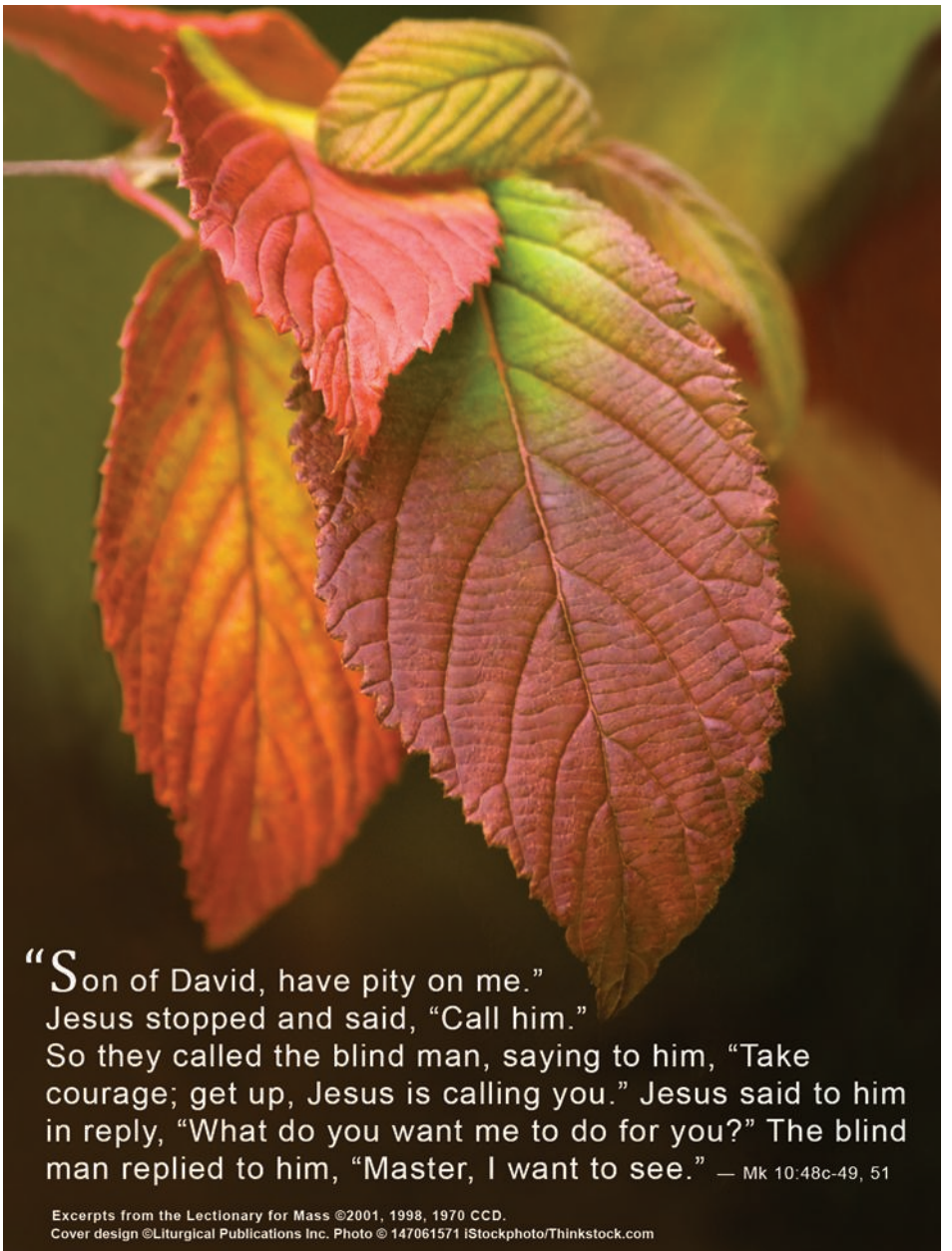

From the Desk of the Parish Director

After months of waiting to hear from the Public Service Commission regarding the dates and times for the public hearings regarding the proposed power lines, we have received notice of these hearings for the general public.

Please mark your calendars for Tuesday, November 27th with two options at 1:00PM and 6:00PM at Wauwatosa City Hall; Common Council Chambers (2nd floor); 7725 W. North Ave.; Wauwatosa.

Additionally, on Tuesday, November 27th, at 9:30AM, the Public Service Commission shall receive evidence from the parties to the proceedings (Wisconsin Electric Power Company, American Transmission Company) and the Public Service Commission staff in the Common Council Chambers at the Wauwatosa City Hall. If necessary, the hearing may continue on Wednesday, November 28th in the Amnicon Falls Hearing Room at the Public Service Commission Building (610 N. Whitney Way; Madison, WI).

If you would like to review all the documents submitted to the PSC, 1) go to the PSC website at <http://psc.wi.gov> and 2) enter 5-CE-139 in the box labeled "Link Directly to a Case," and select "GO."

There are four ways to make your concerns, comments, and views known. **IT IS CRITICALLY IMPORTANT FOR OUR FUTURE THAT WE VOICE OUR STATEMENT FOR BURIED POWER LINES.**

1) **Web Comment:** Go to the Public Service Commission's website at <http://psc.wi.gov>, click on "Public Comments" button on the side menu bar. On the next page, select the "File a comment" link that appears for docket number 5-CE-139. **Web comments shall be received no later than Monday, November 26th.**

2) **Oral Comment:** Spoken testimony at the public sessions on Tuesday, November 27th.

3) **Written Comment:** Instead of speaking at the hearing, write out a comment and submit it at the public sessions

on Tuesday, November 27th.

4) **U. S. Mail Comment:** All comments submitted by U. S. Mail shall be received **no later than Monday, November 26th.** A mail comment shall include the phrase "Docket 5-CE-139 Comments" in the heading and shall be addressed to:

The Commission will not accept comment submitted via e-mail or fax.

The Public Service Commission further instructs "a person shall limit a public comment to non-technical personal knowledge or personal opinion. A person may include references to other materials in a comment, but may not include, as part of a comment, any document not written or substantially modified by that person. The Commission shall only accept document that a person offers to supplement a comment for the purpose of showing the basis of an opinion, not for proof of the matter asserted. Parties may object to the receipt of a public comment."

Now is the time for us to take action and advocate for our parish community and our neighborhood. Plan on attending the public hearing. If you cannot attend, then please send written comments to the PSC as instructed above. We have a chance to influence the decision for placement of the power lines. Let's not let this opportunity pass us by.

St. Therese advises us to do what we can, and this is something we ALL can do!

May God guide us and all parties involved in this decision!

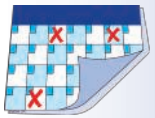
