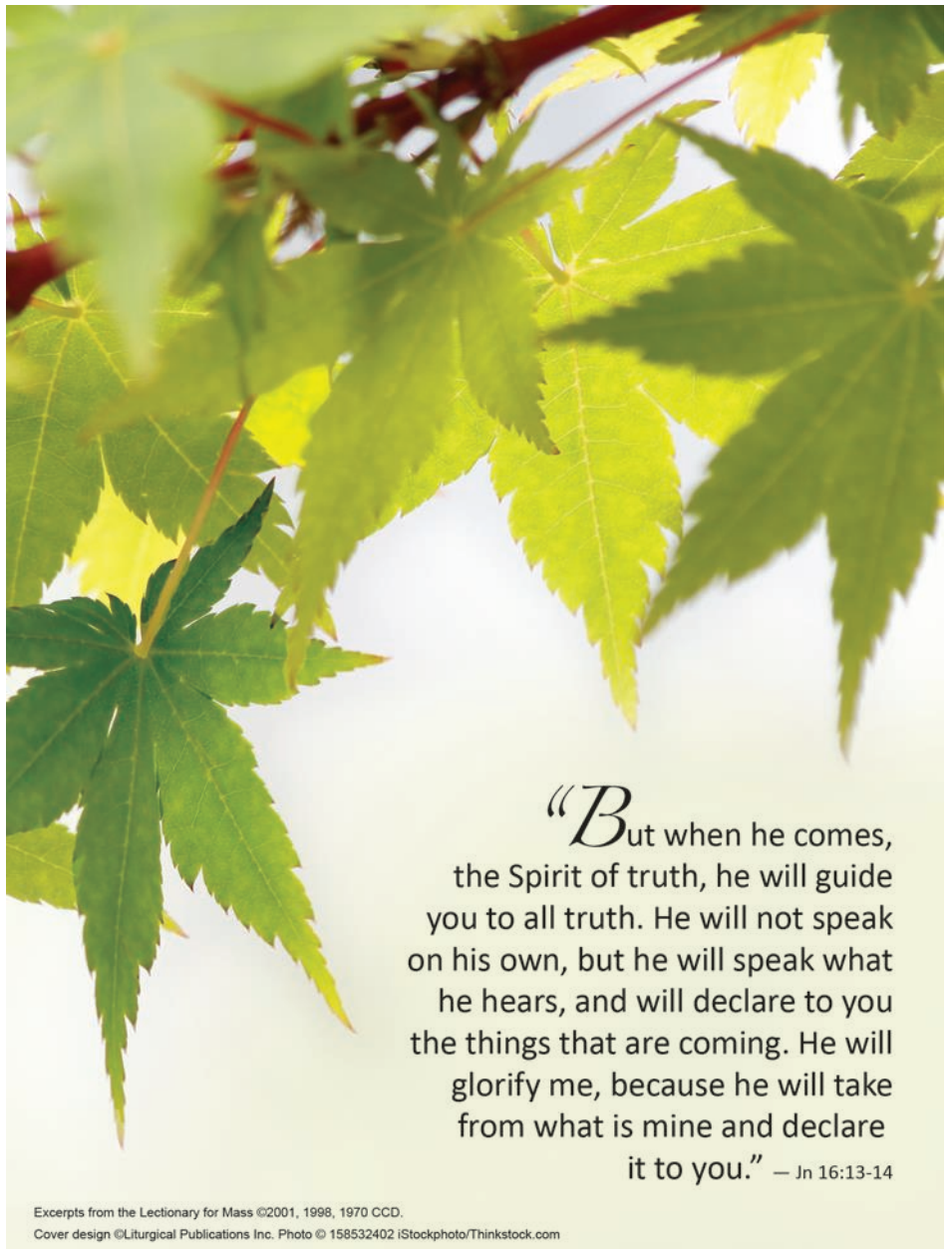

From the Desk of the Parish Director

• At the Annual Meeting on May 5th, there were some questions raised regarding the status of our Air Conditioning Project and Restricted Fund. I would like to address the questions and thank those who raised these for our parish community.

Q: When were the bids for mini-splits, traditional, and geothermal acquired?

A: Late summer 2010 and early spring 2011.

Q: Who were the vendors willing to give us a bid (without a definite commitment to the project)?

A: For traditional air conditioning—Donovan and Jorgenson, Inc. for a conventional Sanyo-Eco-I heat pump system—total cost with discount and subcontracted electric work—\$106,990.

For mini-slips, Consolidated Air Conditioning and Heating with Roman Electric Company for electrical work for five mini-splits—total cost \$55,681.

For geothermal air-conditioning, verbal estimate from Professional Geothermal Systems for \$245,000.

Q: How much is in our Air Conditioning Reserve Account?

A: As of April 30th, we have \$22,185.46.

Q: Are donations still coming in?

A: Yes, you may note that each week the amount of donations received is published in the bulletin. Some of our membership are contributing weekly, monthly, quarterly, or yearly. Also we have received donations from persons who attend mass here at St. Therese occasionally but are not registered members.

Q: Where are we now with our air conditioning project?

A: We have decided (Prayer and Worship Committee, and Parish Council) to limit the options for air conditioning to mini-splits and geothermal. Traditional air conditioning has been removed.

Q: Will we have to get bids again?

A: Yes, the bids we do have are not current.

Q: When will we know if the project will go forward?

A: At this point, we are continuing our funding efforts, and we will be submitting a grant application to WE Energies for geothermal.

Q: To whom do we address any further questions?

A: Dr. David Borst is our Chairperson for this project. Please contact him or submit your concerns/comments to addressed to him in care of the Parish Office.

• At the Annual Meeting, we also reviewed the process for the decision regarding the mass schedule beginning September 7th/8th:

1. The Christian Formation Committee and Prayer and Worship Committee will be discussing the schedule and reviewing all the comments, concerns, and suggestions submitted to them at their May and June meetings. (Christian Formation Committee met on May 19th, and Prayer and Worship Committee meets on May 26th)

2. By June 30th, the Christian Formation Committee and Prayer and Worship Committee send their recommendations for the mass schedule to the Parish Council.

3. The Parish Council reviews the recommendations and proposes the mass schedule to Dr. Guliano.

4. The new mass schedule will be published the weekend of July 13th/14th.

Please submit your comments, concerns, and suggestions to any member of the Christian Formation Committee, Prayer and Worship Committee, or Parish Council, and thank you for taking the time to do so!

May St. Therese of Lisieux, our patron, intercede for us as we continue to work on these projects and make decisions for the parish community.

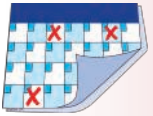

Parents and guardians play a key role in the success of parish programs for young people. Involvement and communication are important factors in helping to ensure safe environments for all of our children.

Combined Collections: The Church in the United States

All registered households in the Archdiocese of Milwaukee will be receiving a mailing and appeal to support the Combined Collections: The Church in the United States. The five ministries supported by this appeal include:

Black and Indian Missions reach out to those who seek Christ in what is often a hostile environment. Approximately half of the funds collected are returned to our archdiocese to assist local projects and initiatives.

Catholic Campaign for Human Development (CCSD) confronts the causes of poverty, rather than merely treating its symptoms. With the archbishop's approval, CCJD makes both national and local grants each year to create jobs, improve education, and strengthen neighborhoods.

Catholic University of America is the national university of the Catholic Church. This collection underwrites scholarships to assist financially deserving students in completing their education.

Catholic Communications Campaign develops media programming and resources that promote Gospel values. Within the Archdiocese of Milwaukee, thousands of homebound Catholics have access to the Sunday radio and television masses, and many more enjoy hearing spiritual messages from the archbishop on local radio and TV.

Retirement Fund for Religious distributes grants to religious institutes for the retirement needs of senior religious priests, brothers, and sisters.
