## From the Desk of the Parish Director

- This weekend we celebrate Trinity Sunday, the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity of Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The dogma of the Trinity is a central mystery of our faith—one God in Three Persons. The theologian Catherine Mowry LaCugna has described the Trinity as “God For Us,” as Creator, as Redeemer, as Sanctifying and Ever-Present Spirit.
- Happy Father’s Day! This weekend we give thanks for all men who nurture children of any age—fathers, grandfathers, uncles, godfathers, step-fathers, and all who are like fathers to us. Let us also pray for those fathers who are deceased and those who have lost their fathers to death since last Father’s Day.
- Last weekend, David Borst gave an update on our Air Conditioning Project. Currently our fund is at approximately \$25,000. We began the fund in July, 2012 and have been making slow but steady progress. It’s time to step up the funding because recommendations regarding the project were made last week, which will be reviewed by the Finance Council at its June 17th meeting. (The Air Conditioning Committee consists of David Borst (Funding Chair), Pat Hall (Prayer and Worship Committee), Richard Hopefl (Parish Pastoral Council), Kathy Hubrich (Trustee-Secretary), Jim Balliet (Trustee-Treasurer), Dan Goeden, and Denise Dostalek). Following are the recommendations:
  1. Move the Air Conditioning Project from the Prayer and Worship Committee to the Building and Grounds Committee for the due diligence regarding installation, costs, and upkeep.
  2. Eliminate the geothermal option and choose the

option of mini-slips. While we submitted four grant applications, we have not received any responses. At this point in time, the cost for the mini-slips is markedly less than geothermal (geothermal would cost approximately \$250,000; mini-slips \$70,000 to \$100,000).

3. Set Summer of 2015 as the target date for completion of the project unless, of course, the parish funds the project earlier. In other words, “if we had the full amount to fund the project today, we would start the project immediately.” We have been told that the installation of mini-slips would take two to three weeks.
4. The Finance Council reports that some of our membership have stated they would donate for air conditioning once a decision was made regarding what option we would adopt.
5. With the upcoming construction, including the closing of the Bluemound bridge in October and the ongoing creation of an exit ramp to the west of our property, the noise and dust factor will affect our worship space significantly. If we are unable to open the church windows, cooling the worship space will be an ever greater challenge.

If you have any questions or concerns regarding the Air Conditioning Project, please contact one of the members of the committee listed above. The above five recommendations will be reviewed by the Finance Council on June 17th, and they will make the final decisions regarding the Air Conditioning Project.

## Art & Environment Committee Reorganizing

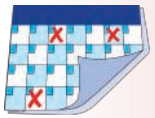

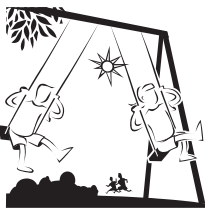

## Next Weekend is Sharing Weekend

This month's sharing Recipient is Kathy's House. Located just blocks from St. Therese, Kathy's House provides lodging and a supportive environment to families who are experiencing personal illness or the serious illness of a loved one. Since opening in 2001, Kathy's House has served as a "home away from home" to nearly 6,000 families who need to travel to Milwaukee for medical care and is the only hospital hospitality house in Milwaukee that serves patients of all ages. Guests stay anywhere from one night to several months with the average stay being eight days.

Kathy's House was founded by a Milwaukee-area couple following the death of their adult daughter, Kathy, in 2000. Seventy five percent of referred patients are being treated for cancer or a cancer-related illness. Patients and their caregivers benefit from the individual attention and support provided by Kathy's House staff and volunteers. Families also derive support from one another as they go through medical challenges. Please be generous with your support.

## Family Dance Nights for Gym Lights

The Building & Grounds Committee is hosting three family dance nights to raise money for energy saving lighting in Heck Hall. Our current T12 bulbs and Ballasts have been banned from production by the Department of Energy so we are going to change over to the government preferred T8 high efficiency bulbs and ballasts. In addition to being compliant we will also gain a savings of approximately \$650 per year.

## Important News for Parents/Guardians Regarding Requirements for 1st Reconciliation/1st Communion and Youth Confirmation

- To begin the preparation for 1st Reconciliation/1st Communion, one year of catechesis is required. 1st Reconciliation/1st Communion preparation will begin in September and registration for the preparation will begin this Spring. Children ages 7 and older who have completed a year of catechesis (or home school catechesis) are welcome.
- To begin the preparation for youth Confirmation, two years of high school catechesis are required. Youth Confirmation candidates must be 16 years old at the time of Confirmation. Youth Confirmation preparation begins in September and ends with the celebration of the Sacrament of confirmation with our cluster parishes during the Easter Season.
