

From the Desk of the Parish Director

Over the summer, since we have been promoting both the Air Conditioning Fund and Father Roger Heck Memorial Organ Fund in our bulletin, I have been asked, "Why do we have both funding campaigns going on at the same time?"

Good question.

We have been accepting donations for the Air Conditioning Fund since the summer of 2012. At that time, three options for cooling the church were proposed –1) traditional air conditioning, 2) geothermal, and 3) mini-slips. In the course of the past two years, options 1) and 2) were eliminated, and our focus now is on funding 3), mini-slips. I have asked Denise Dostalek, Building Services Coordinator and the Building and Grounds Committee to procure bids for minislips no later than September 1st so that we determine the remaining fundraising needed for fully funding the project. Years ago, we were quoted \$60,000 to \$100,000; but, as you may know, costs fluctuate.

Over the past year, our organ stopped functioning at some critical moments. At one of our large funerals, it stopped working; and, it was only due to our musician's (Sterling Biggers and Elterine Jankowski-Biggers) creativity and ingenuity that we were able to finish the liturgy with sung prayer. On Christmas Eve, it simply stopped working again! A "911 call" to a very generous organ repair person and his immediate response helped us have organ music for the Christmas Eve and Christmas Day liturgies. At other times, certain stops and pedals "died."

Each time the repairs have been costly; and we have been informed that replacement parts are no longer available. Technology has far surpassed our aging organ.

As often happens in life, things break down. We may have

thought we could avoid purchasing a newer car or appliance only to discover that it is wiser to purchase newer.

Sterling Biggers, our organist and accompanist, has offered to answer any questions you may have regarding the purchase of the new organ. Please contact him.

The Finance Council approved both of these capital projects because they recognized both are needed for our parish community and its continued life. While donations have been slow, they have been steady. To date, the Finance Council considers these as separate capital projects for which we have approved proxies from Archbishop Listecki.

Another question is, "Will we use any of the money received from the sale of our land and easements to fund these projects?" At the present time, the Finance Council has not approved any reserve funds for these projects. Use of reserved funds for capital projects requires the approval of the Finance Council, Parish Director/Pastor, and a proxy from the Archbishop and Vicar General. The parish is always informed through the bulletin when this happens.

Please watch the bulletin each week. An accounting is given of all the various donations to the parish–Envelopes and Offertory (our tithes), Air Conditioning Donations, Organ Fund Donations, Maintenance Donations, and other collections (Sharing Sunday, Mission Appeal). And, if you have any questions regarding the status of any fund, please contact Lisa Vallone, Bookkeeper, in the Parish Office.

Thanks for your continued stewardship and financial support of our parish community and its ministries and for our special projects.

Utility Work Update

Over the next few weeks, you will see some larger equipment on the property. WE Energies is in the process of moving the distribution lines from above ground to below ground. They will be installing a new pole and transformer located in the south east corner of our green space. They are also installing new electric meters for the building. WE Energies is also in the process of changing the location of our gas service line and will also be installing a new gas meter for the building. ATC is in the beginning stages of erecting the large power line poles for the medical complex. Data Comm is doing work along Bluemound and down 95th St. to 92nd St. Their vehicles may be in our parking lot, however they are not working directly on our property. Lawn Care Update

Due to the large quantity of work being done on the green space to the west and along the side walk on Bluemound Road, the lawn crew will suspend mowing in those areas until further notice. This is for the safety of our crew, to prevent damage to our equipment, and to keep all of the utility markers in place for WE Energies (both the Electric and Gas divisions) and ATC. All other areas will be cared for as usual. Each of the contractors working on the property is responsible for any and all repairs to the property resulting from damages to the green space and our parking lot upon completion of the work.
