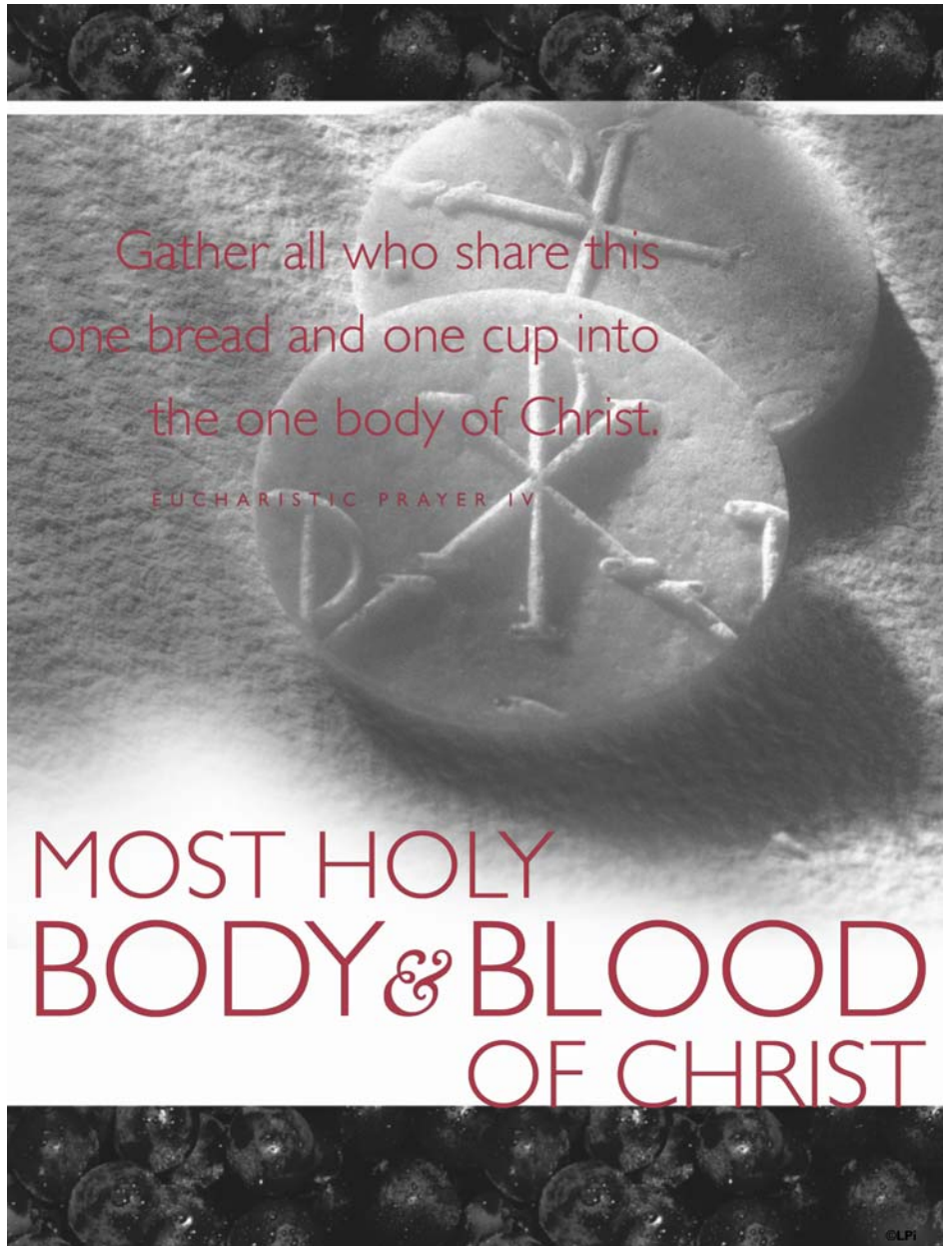

Several years ago, I attended a conference entitled, "We Are The Body of Christ—What If We Meant What We Said." The entire weekend workshops, speakers, and events focused on "walking the talk" as members of the Body of Christ.

This weekend we celebrated the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ; in earlier days known as "Corpus Christi." We set aside one weekend each year to immerse ourselves in the mystery of the Christ given for us who transforms us into His Body. This feast gives us an opportunity to reflect on our own actions as a member of His Body. Are our actions consistent with what we profess and believe? 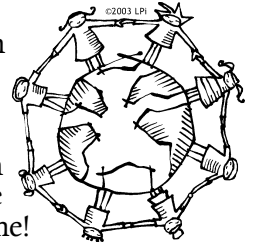
