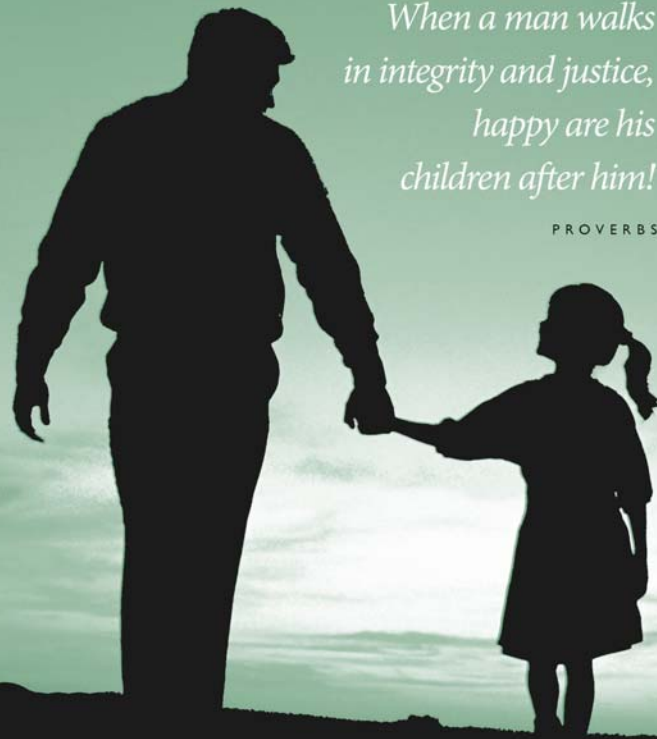

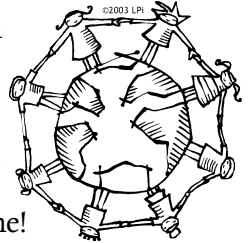

Benedict Center 2007 River Walk June 24th, Pere Marquette Park

The Benedict Center is in its 33rd year working with victims, offenders, and the community to achieve a system of justice that is fair and treats everyone with dignity and respect. The Center sponsors four interrelated programs: Women's Harm Reduction, Justice Advocacy, Interfaith Jail Chaplain and Outreach, and the Sisters Project (street intervention with women involved in prostitution and drugs). You can support the Benedict Center by participating in the River Walk, which starts and finishes at Pere Marquette Park (Kilbourn and Third St. in downtown Milwaukee). The walk is animal friendly, so you can register your dog, too!

The schedule is as follows:

9:00AM to 10:30AM Walk-up Registration

11:00AM Welcoming Remarks, Release of balloons, and walk starts

12:00PM Closing Ceremony, Prizes Awarded and picnic in Pere Marquette Park (Bring your own picnic or buy from vendors)

Youth Ministry Team Forming

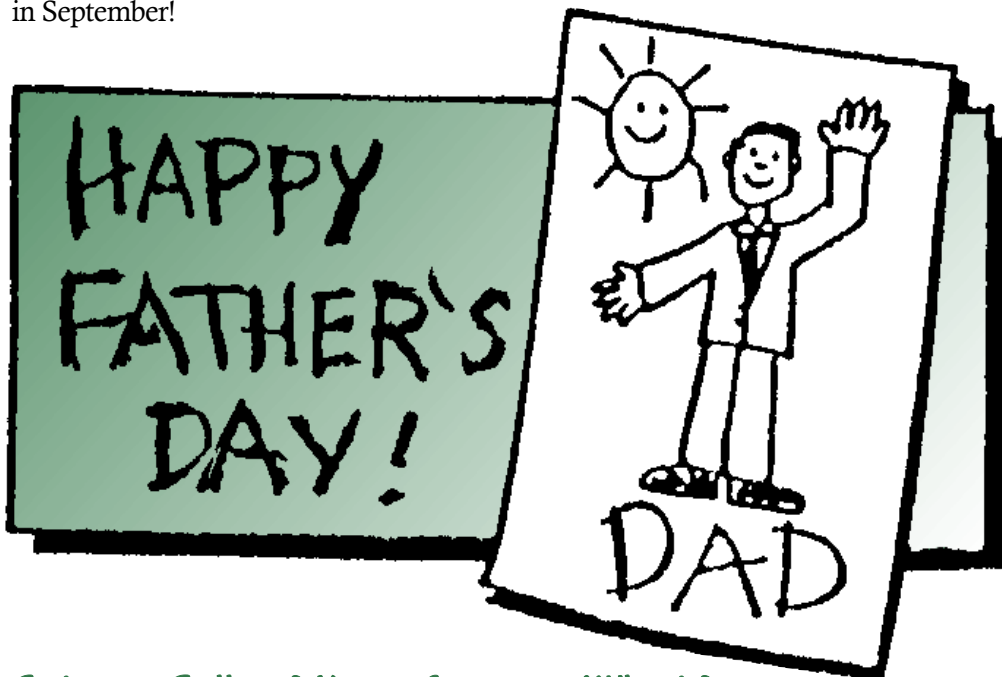
