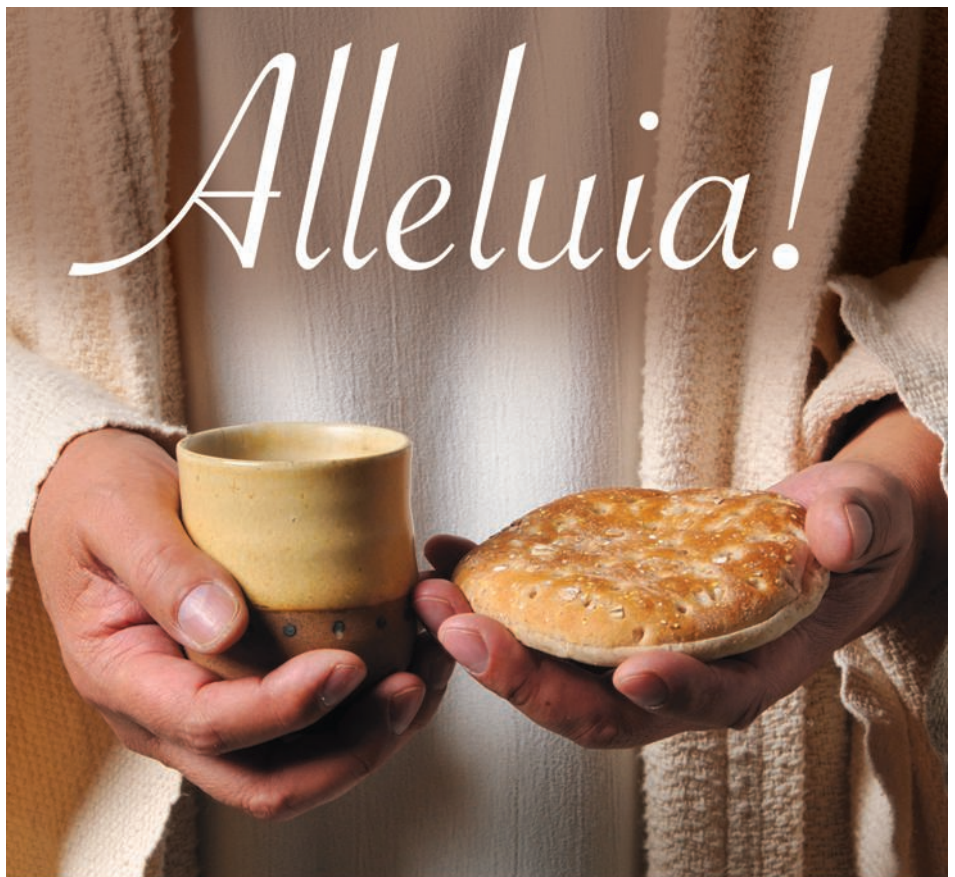

## From the Desk of the Parish Director

Copies of the 2011–2012 Parish Operating Budget are available on the tables at the entrances of the church. Please take a few moments to review this budget. Our fiscal year begins on July 1st and ends on June 30th. After the 2010–2011 fiscal year books are closed, we will present a financial report for the year.

Like many institutions and organizations, we cut our projected expenses for the 2010–2011 year and reduced our staffing by 1.75 FTE. We did not fill three positions which were vacated due to retirement and resignation. For eight months of the current fiscal year, we operated *very lean* and were able to have a positive balance of revenues vs. expenses most months. In March, we were able to add a .25 FTE Administrative Assistant II position. In May, we were able to increase the Administrative Assistant II position to .5 FTE. As we did this, we were very careful to restore only what we projected that we could support by our cash flow and contributions.

What has helped us immeasurably during this past fiscal year has been the Special Donations that our members and benefactors give in addition to their financial stewardship commitment. With these Special Donations, we have added nine trees to our green space, funded some projects that were not in the operating budget, like the replacement of the water fountains (“bubblers”), and relieving the budget for payment of items like vestments, candles, altar breads, wine, ritual books, and more. Thanks to all who are/were so generous to the parish! Thanks, also, to those who are not parish members who gave Special Donations to our parish.

Further, we give thanks for the Memorials given to the parish in honor of our deceased members. While we received no bequests this fiscal year, we did receive a number of memorials, ranging from approximately \$75.00 to \$1000. Our deepest gratitude to the families who included St. Therese Parish in their memorial of their loved ones.

Finally, we thank our parish trustees, Jim Balliet, Trustee-Treasurer, and Kathy Hubrich, Trustee-Secretary for their generosity of time and talent in helping steward our financial gifts; and to our Finance/Administration Committee members – Doug Sedlar, Chairperson; Janet Krebs, Vice-Chairperson; Mary Bunzel, Secretary; Joel Simpson, Matthew Thompson, Michael Falk, Mari Pavleje, Dave Drodowicz, and Lisa Vallone, Bookkeeper – for their consistent care and concern for our parish vitality and viability.

Let us continue to give thanks for our many blessings, and let us never forget that God cannot be outdone in generosity!

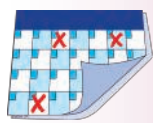

## This Week is Sharing Sunday

The recipient of this month's Sharing is Works of Mercy Summer Camp. This camp provides persons with developmental disabilities a week's vacation in a controlled setting with regularly scheduled events and activities as well as providing volunteers with an opportunity to learn about the needs of persons with disabilities.

Campers are paired with volunteer counselors. Together, they experience camp activities that include arts and crafts, nature hikes, outdoor recreational games, music, talent shows, and movies. Each day also includes time for the celebration of the Eucharist and prayer or reflection on themes such as honesty, trust, thankfulness, and hope.

## Question on the Roman Missal, Third Edition

### What's new or different about the revised translation?

The style of the translation of the third edition is different. In accord with the rules for translation established by the Holy See, the revised translation follows the style of the original Latin texts more closely, including concrete images, repetition, parallelisms, and rhythm. The English used in the Mass texts is more formal and dignified in style. Where possible, the texts follow the language of Scripture and include many poetic images.

In addition, the third edition contains prayers for the celebration of recently canonized saints, additional prefaces for the Eucharistic Prayers, additional Masses and prayers for various needs and intentions, and some updated and revised rubrics (or instructions) for the celebration of the Mass.
