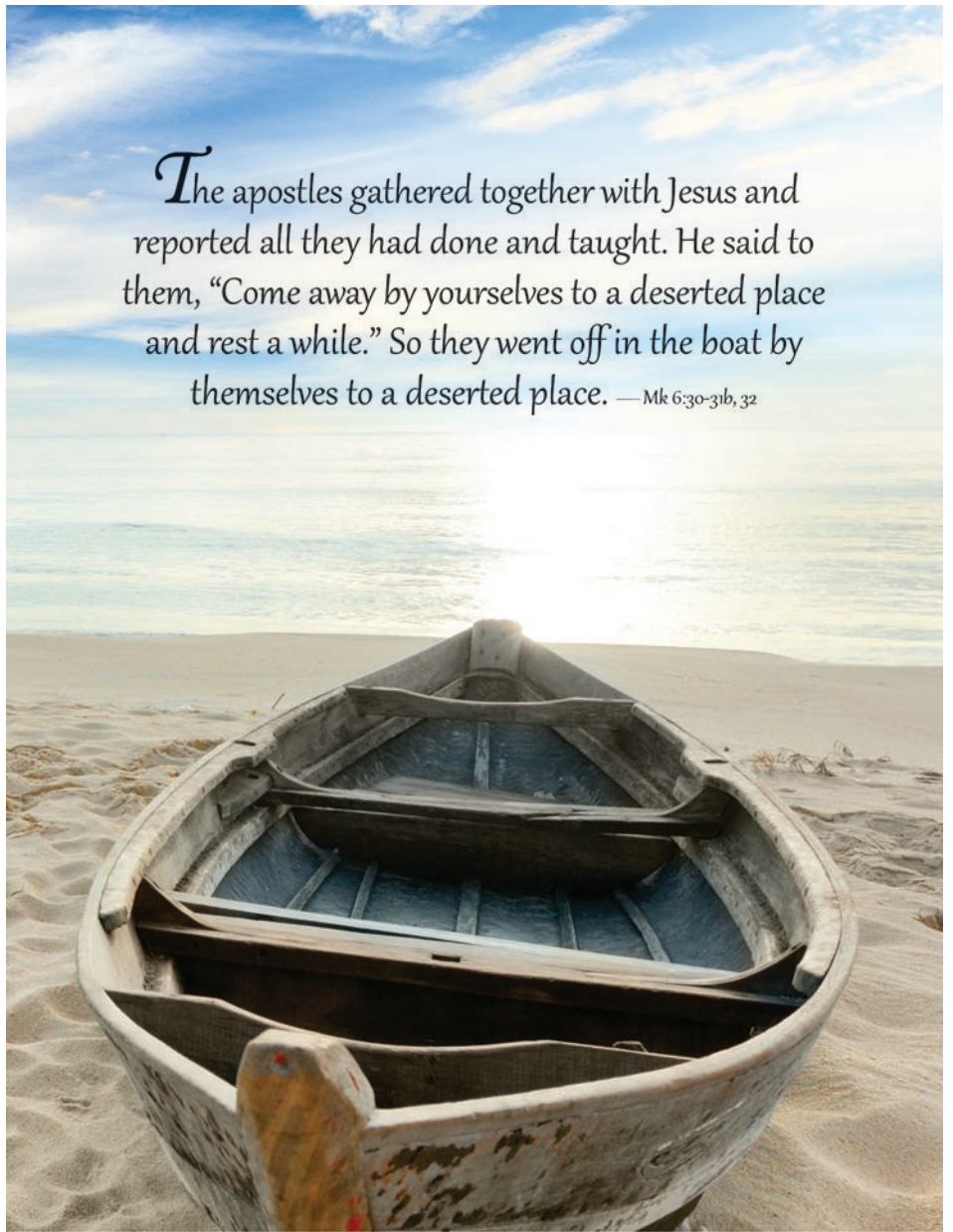

From the Desk of the Parish Director

◆ Last Saturday, July 14th, we celebrated the Mass of Christian Burial for Sister Sara Jean Donegan, SSND. Sister Sara Jean served our parish over the past ten years as Lector, Eucharistic Minister, Sacristan, Strategic Planning Committee member, and porter. As porter, she quietly and unceremoniously took responsibility for unlocking the church every weekend for an hour before the Saturday 5:00PM mass and early on Sunday mornings. She did this faithfully for our parish community for ten years! In addition, she assisted Sister Margit Loeffler, SSND in the cleaning and care of the linens needed for the celebrations of the Eucharist—the purificators and corporals.

Professionally, she was a dentist with offices at the SSND motherhouse in Elm Grove. Additionally, she taught at Marquette University Dental School, specializing in restorative dentistry. Over the years, she taught thousands of students and cared for hundreds of patients.

- ◆ Just a week earlier, we celebrated the Mass of Christian Burial for Frank Zareczny, our much-loved guitar and banjo player for our St. Therese Choir. A little less than two years ago, Frank was diagnosed with inoperable brain cancer. Despite his diagnosis, he lived his life to the fullest, with a strong faith and indomitable spirit. One of the memories I hold is Frank's playing his original music at our evening Good Friday liturgy. His love for God and faith in Our Lord Jesus Christ were expressed through his music.
- ◆ Sister Sara Jean and Frank are examples of who we are as a faith community here at St. Therese. And our response to their loss is an illustration of what kind of parish community we are. Over the past two weeks, we saw a number of our parishioners, living the "Little Way of St Therese," by reaching out and "walking hand in hand" and serving as musicians and singers, liturgical ministers, funeral lunch servers, bakers, hospitality ministers, and many other "behind the scenes" support tasks.

Thanks to all who helped in any way as we ministered to the families of Frank Zareczny and Sister Sara Jean Donegan, SSND.

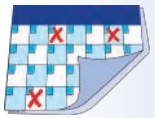

Proclaiming Christ to a Secular Culture

Rev. Robert Barron, STD, recently named rector and president of the University of St. Mary on the Lake/Mundelein Seminary, will present the 2012 Pallium Lecture, "Proclaiming Christ to a Secular Culture." Fr. Barron is the writer and host of *CATHOLICISM*, a ground breaking, 10-part documentary series about the Catholic faith and founder of Word on Fire (www.WordOnFire.org).
